AM I ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible to apply you should have, or be predicted to achieve, a minimum of a 2:1 in a French, German or Spanish degree and meet the criteria at <https://www.gov.uk/student-finance/who-qualifies>.

Candidates with 2:1 degrees in other subjects who demonstrate excellent language skills and significant knowledge may also apply.

Candidates with a 2:2, or predicted 2:2 degree in the language, a relevant PhD or Master's degree, or recognised equivalent and substantial relevant experience, may also be considered in exceptional circumstances.

You should also be in an eligible non-salaried route into teaching by September 2020. You do not need this to be secured to apply for the scholarship.
